

# Transfer Test analysis - September 2022 entry

Initial update

This data is presented with the permission of The Buckinghamshire Grammar Schools.

## Notes

Table includes all pupils that registered for a transfer test and obtained a mark.

Pupils are automatically registered for the transfer test if they attend a Buckinghamshire maintained Primary school (opt out). They can withdraw from the test by notifying their school in writing. Parents of pupils going to all other schools are required to register for the transfer test if they wish their child to participate (opt in).

The overall qualification mark is 121.

The final test marks for the 2022 entry are standardised according to methodology

Resident LA is derived from the Easting and Northing coordinates in the raw data.

'Post review qualifiers' is the total pupils who have qualified after a successful selection review.

'Total Qualified' is the number of pupils that have qualified for a grammar place, including successful selection review pupils

'Registered for test' means the pupil has sat the Transfer test.

'Overall Cohort' means the total number of pupils in the respective Capita ONE report including those that did not sit the Transfer Test.

Cells with fewer than 5 pupils are shown as '<5'
